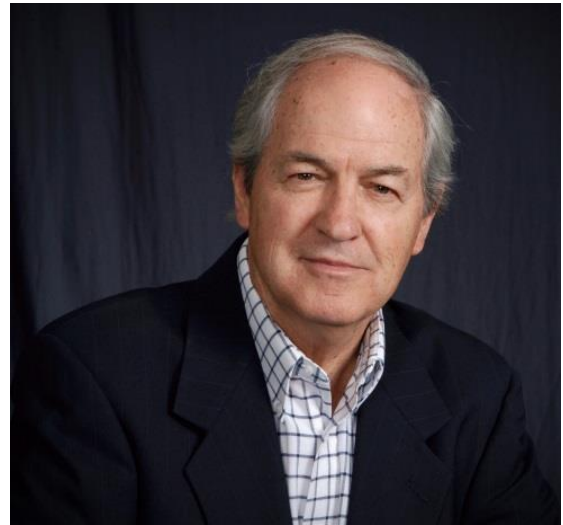


The Awakening

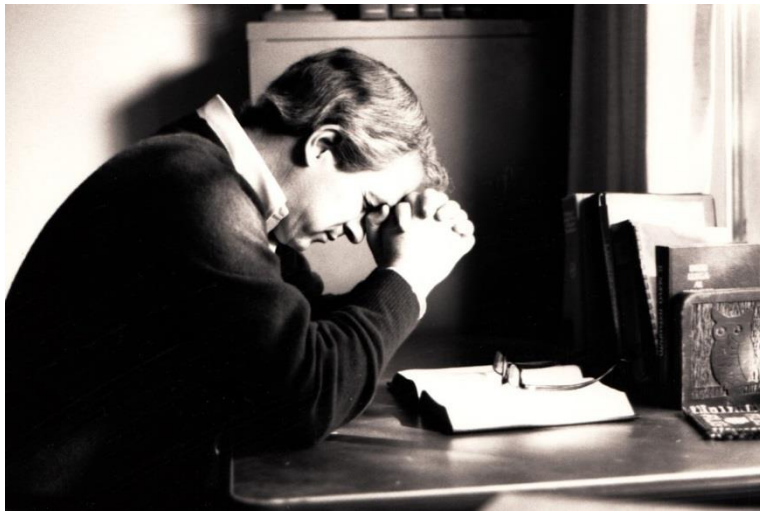

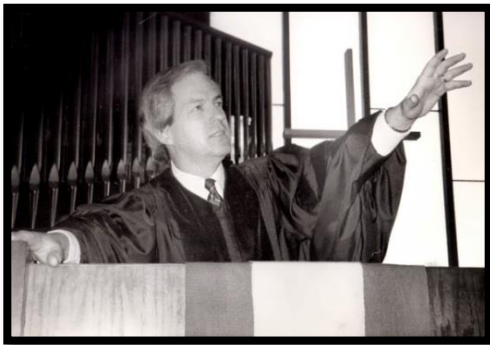


It started with a Call, a Call that would not leave Kimball...

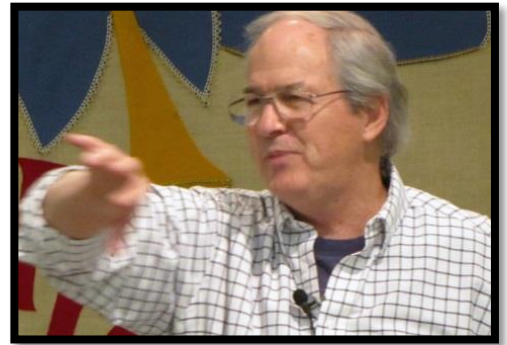
